REFERENDUM UPDATE

DRIVING FORCES FOR FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT

- To improve and expand programs at MLHS
- ▶ To offer increased exposure to hands on STEM and ARTS curricula K-12
- ▶ To offer increased instructional time and more flexible master schedules at each building
- To address necessary facility upgrades that are outside the annual capital budget including:
 - School security improvements as recommended by County Office for Homeland Security
 - MLHS Auditorium required renovations
 - Separation and renovation of Briarcliff and MLHS locker rooms
 - Renovation of Wildwood bathrooms to be ADA Compliant

MOUNTAIN LAKES HIGH SCHOOL: ADDED CLASSROOMS ARE ESSENTIAL

- ... so students can maintain optimal schedules: schedules that satisfy scheduling requests
- ... so that students/teachers can learn/teach in appropriate classroom environments
- ... so that teachers have a 'home' classroom so students can better seek extra help and teachers can 'own' classroom environments
- ... so that MLHS can move to an **altered bell schedule** that will have a demonstrable, positive effect on the depth of instruction, pace of school day, and experience of school for all students
- ... so that MLHS can offer premier instructional space for a variety of current and future curricular offerings

BRIARCLIFF SCHOOL: MODERNIZING AND CREATING NEW SPACES

Renovation of the 6th Grade Science Lab and Relocation of Main Office

Creation of a Maker Lab

Renovation of the boys and girls locker rooms which allow for space for the creation of a band room

Renovation of the multi purpose room: replacing the HVAC system, lighting and ceiling

An expanded cafeteria space will greatly increase the the flexibility within the Master Schedule and provide easier and more effective services for lunch. Additionally, with a larger space, the cafeteria can serve as a multi-purpose space for special events

WILDWOOD SCHOOL: IMPROVING SPACES TO MEET CURRENT NEEDS

As with Briarcliff, an expanded cafeteria space will greatly increase the the flexibility within the Master Schedule and provide easier and more effective services for lunch. Additionally, with a larger space, the cafeteria can serve as a multi-purpose space for special events

Improved main office security and windows around the wheel, would create a safer environment for all students and faculty.

Updated bathrooms will provide a more sanitary, safe and accessible environment for all students

An updated expanded Art Room would allow greater storage, more access for long-term projects and potentially expanded After School Art Clubs

A new Band Room would provide our students with an enriched learning environment with no distractions from physical education classes, as well as provide a safe place to store instruments.

The Media Center can only comfortably seat 25 adults/students. The Media Center is the Hub of the Elementary School. Unfortunately, with the current design, the loss of the true sense of the functions of a Library are lost due to the constant disruptions and movement through this area.
