**Subject:** Travel Restrictions Reminder

Dear ML Learning Community,

As a reminder, the MLSD is following the guidelines of the CDC/NJDOH regarding travel. Here's what you need to know:

- If you must travel, domestic and international travelers who are not fully vaccinated must get tested with a viral test 3-5 days after travel AND stay home and self-quarantine for a full 7 days after travel, even if you test negative.
- If testing is not completed post-travel, individuals must self-quarantine for 10 days.
- International travelers who are fully vaccinated do not need to be quarantined from school, but should get tested with a viral test 3-5 days after travel, self-monitor for symptoms, and isolate if symptoms develop.
- Domestic travel is defined as lasting 24 hours or longer to states or U.S. territories other than those connected to New Jersey, such as Pennsylvania, New York, and Delaware.

<u>Please note</u>: Students who are quarantined due to travel will not have access to virtual learning.
